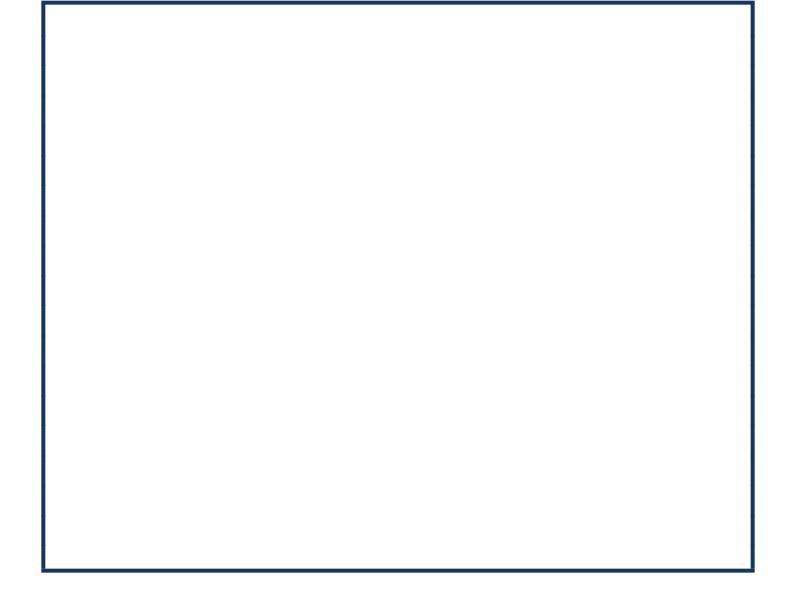

Health Record

Keep track of all routine medical care provided to your SAE project animal. List all vaccinations, medications, dewormers administered by you or your veterinarian. If manufactures information is available for immunizations list information under comments. <u>All expenses should be listed on the Expense Report.</u>
